These are the topics you need to cover:

- in which area did you do your AJ?
- What was your goal or research topic during the AJ?
- how did you work to get results?
- what are the results of your research?
- what did you do to prepare for your AJ: physically, mentally and practically?
- can you tell something about some special moment during the AJ?
- write a short reflection about your own part and role in the group: what went well and not so well and what did you learn? What would you do different next time?

This report (written, filmed or in another way) should be finished 3 weeks after your AJ and should be sent to your Assessor for the final approval of the AJ.
